



## **“The Barrick CanEducate Scholarship” Masters of Mineral Sciences (Mining Engineering) at The University of Zambia.**

### **NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

One scholarship for the two-year master’s degree in Mining Engineering will be awarded on merit-cum-means basis commencing from the academic year 2019 – 2021 based on the eligibility criteria mentioned below:

### **ELIGIBILITY**

**Course, Discipline & Institute** – The Barrick CanEducate scholarship program shall be awarded to a student selected to pursue full-time Post – Graduate in Master of Mineral Sciences degree in Mining Engineering through campus selection. Students having confirmed admission only in the first year of full time are eligible to apply.

**Merit Criteria** – For the merit criteria the following will be considered – Selection Points secured, and percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying/progression entrance examination for the course.

**Age Limit and Gender**– **Female** student with a maximum of 25 years as on the first Semester of the academic admission for the course.

**Others** – The candidate should not be in any kind of employment, should not be in receipt of any other scholarship from any other source and should not have any criminal record. Students in receipt of the Barrick CanEducate Scholarship will not be entitled to draw from any other scholarship/Financial Aid/Stipend from any other source.

### **APPLICATION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP**

Intending applicants must satisfy admission requirements for postgraduate studies (Masters degree in Mineral Sciences in Mining Engineering) at the University of Zambia.

**Application** – Application forms for postgraduate studies can be obtained from the Directorate of Research and Graduate Studies. Application for Barrick CanEducate Scholarship must be made through the “Head, Department of Mining Engineering”, School of Mines, University of Zambia, P.O. Box 32379, Lusaka.

The award will be based on a competitive selection process by the School of Mines Department of Mining Engineering, the Barrick CanEducate Scholarship Program and Ms. Katrina White.

Applications not meeting the above requirements will not be accepted.

**The decision of the company with respect to award of Scholarship and continuance and/or discontinuance as the case may be shall be final and binding.**

#### **GENERAL**

Barrick Lumwana Mining Company and CanEducate reserve the right to alter, modify or withdraw the program as considered necessary.
