- Liaising with other security agencies such as the Zambia Police Service (ZPS), Anti-Corruption Commission, (ACC) and Drug Enforcement Commission, (DEC) on matters relating to the University security and investigations.
- Conducting security sensitization workshops for subordinates as part of training in line with the University policies to enable them acquire knowledge and skills required to meet the dictates of their responsibilities.
- Examining and investigating theft reports in residential areas, schools, departments and other units through shift reports and other sources to establish crime data in terms of type of crime, prevalence and scene of occurrence.
- Representing the Unit at preparatory meetings for Student Orientations, Registration and Graduation.
