#### JOB PURPOSE AND REPORTING RELATIONSHIP:

Reporting directly to the Vice-Chancellor, the Dean is responsible for the overall performance of the School, including directing academic, administrative and financial activities of the School.

#### PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES

- · Controls and coordinates all activities and operations of the School;
- Initiates the formulation of policies and guidelines governing the operations of the School;
- Ensures implementation of policies and guidelines governing the operations of the School;
