BLOCK RELEASE PROGRAMME

Applications are invited from qualified persons to read for a Post Graduate Diploma in Monitoring and Evaluation in the 2021 Academic Year which starts in January 2021.

An applicant must possess the following minimum qualifications:

1. A Bachelor's degree or equivalent from a recognised university.

A Certificate in Monitoring and Evaluation from the Centre of Excellence of the Department of Population Studies at the University of Zambia will be an added advantage.

METHOD OF APPLYING

An applicant must:

1. Apply using the University of Zambia Online Application portal at www.unza.zm

To get to the application portal select Apply now>>Postgraduate programmes>>School of Humanities and Social Sciences>>2021January>>Postgraduate Diploma in Monitoring and Evaluation>>Apply

2. A non-refundable application fee of K150 and \$60 for non-Zambians is required to complete the application process. The application fee should be paid to ZANACO using the bill master form retrieved from your application process with your full details.

Other application Documents to upload

- 1. Copies of relevant Bachelor's Degree
- 2. Detailed transcript
- 3. One page motivation explaining why the applicant wishes to undertake the programme.
- 4. Curriculum Vitae
- 5. Copy of Passport or National Registration Card

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The programme comprises of 5 taught modules (3 block releases plus an Evaluation project).

Block 1 (Module 1 and 2)-Five days

Block 2 (Module 3 and 4)-Five days

Block 3 (Module 5)-Seven days

STUDY DURATION

The study period for this programme is strictly 1 year.
