1. Four (4) Years for School Leavers
2. Three Years for Certificate Holder Nurses and Midwives
3. Two Years for Diploma Holder Nurses and Midwives

MODE OF TEACHING AND LEARNING

1. Bachelor of Science in Nursing- Full Time **OR** Blended (online and face-to-face)
2. Bachelor of Science in Public Health Nursing - Full Time only
3. Bachelor of Science in Mental Health Nursing – Full Time only.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE THREE PROGRAMMES

First Year Entry

- i. School Leavers with Five ‘O’ Levels at Credit or better in English, Mathematics, Biology/ Sciences and any other two subjects
- ii. School Leavers shall enter through the School of Natural Sciences

Second Year Entry

- i. Four international ‘A’ Levels with at least passes (grade C) in Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology from a recognized institution
OR
- ii. Five ‘O’ Levels at credit or better in English, and Mathematics, Biology/ Sciences any other two subjects,
- iii. AND Certificate in Nursing, Diploma in Mental Health Nursing or Certificate in Midwifery
- iv. AND A valid practicing license

Third Year Entry

- i. At least five ‘O’ Levels at Credit or better in English, Mathematics, Biology/ Sciences and any other two subjects
- ii. AND a Diploma in Nursing or Midwifery
- iii. AND A valid practicing license.
