REVISED SESSIONAL DATES CALENDAR OF THE 2020/2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

The University of Zambia Senate, at its special meeting held on **Thursday, 15th April, 2021**, resolved that the University will continue to invite its students in a phased manner and will employ a blended approach of face-to-face and online learning during the 2020/21 Academic Year as follows:

FIRST YEAR STUDENTS

First Year Students will continue with face-to-face learning up to **28th May 2021**.

SECOND YEAR STUDENTS

Second Year Students to report for face-to-face learning on **7th June 2021**, and depart on **28th August 2021** with the following variations:

- ❖ School of Law 3rd Year Students (131) to report on **7th June 2021**.
- ❖ School of Humanities and Social Sciences French Language students (36) to report on **7th June 2021**.
- ❖ All 5th Year Students (298) to report on **7th June 2021**.

THIRD AND FOURTH YEAR STUDENTS

All third and four-year Students to report on **6th September, 2021** for face-to-face lessons.

VETERINARY MEDICINE AND CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE STUDENTS

Veterinary Medicine students and Confucius Institute students to continue with face-to-face lessons until the end of the 2020/2021 Academic Year.

OTHER CATEGORIES OF STUDENTS

Categories of students who will not be on campus at each point to continue learning via online platforms.

STUDENTS AT RIDGEWAY CAMPUS

All students at Ridgeway campus to continue learning via blended learning until the end of the 2020/2021 Academic Year.

POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Postgraduate students to also continue learning via blended learning until the end of the academic year.
