AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES	<p>Minimum of a credit in five O’Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics <b>OR</b> English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject <b>OR</b> Three A-Level passes in Chemistry, Biology, Physics or Mathematics <b>OR</b> A diploma in Agricultural Sciences or related studies from an institution affiliated to the University of Zambia <b>OR</b> A diploma classified as credit or better</p> <p>NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Applicants with only O’Level qualifications who will be admitted to the School of Agricultural Sciences will be required to take first year courses in the School of Natural Sciences.</li> <li>b) Applicants with A-Level or Diploma qualifications may be admitted at either second or third year level to the School of Agricultural Sciences.</li> </ul>
EDUCATION	<p>Minimum of a credit in five O’Levels which must include English Language</p> <p>NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Applicants with relevant Degrees or Diplomas may be admitted at 2nd or 3rd year level.</li> <li>b) Applicants for the Bachelor of Education with Science will need a Minimum of a credit in five O’Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics <b>OR</b> English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject</li> </ul>
HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES	<p>Minimum of a credit in five O’Levels including English Language and any other any four (4) subjects of which one must be an Art</p>
NATURAL SCIENCES	<p>Minimum of a credit in five O’Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics <b>OR</b> English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject.</p>

PUBLIC HEALTH	<p>Minimum of a credit in five O’Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics <b>OR</b> English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject <b>OR</b> a diploma in Environmental Health or related studies from a recognized institution or college affiliated to the University of Zambia.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b></p> <p>(a) Applicants with only O’Level qualifications who will be admitted to the School of Public Health will be required to take first year courses in the School of Natural Sciences.</p> <p>(b) Applicants with A-Level or Diploma qualifications may be admitted at either second or third year level to the School of Public Health.</p>

**HOW TO APPLY:**

Application forms can be obtained from the Customer Service Centre, UNZA Great East Road campus, upon payment of a non-refundable application fee of K150.00 for Zambians or USD 60.00 for non-Zambians. Payment for application forms should be made either at Standard Chartered Bank, Account Number **0100110273800** or First National Bank Zambia (FNB), Account Number **62607694371** or ZANACO account number **0306506302182**. The account name is UNZA Registrars Department. Kindly ensure that the deposit slip bears full details of the applicant as well as the University.
