ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

SCHOOL	REQUIREMENTS
AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES	Minimum of a credit in five O'Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics OR English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject OR Three A-Level passes in Chemistry, Biology, Physics or Mathematics OR A diploma in Agricultural Sciences or related studies from an institution affiliated to the University of Zambia OR A diploma classified as credit or better
EDUCATION	NOTE: a) Applicants with only O'Level qualifications who will be admitted to the School of Agricultural Sciences will be required to take first year courses in the School of Natural Sciences. b) Applicants with A-Level or Diploma qualifications may be admitted at either second or third year level to the School of Agricultural Sciences. Minimum of a credit in five O'Levels which must include English Language
	NOTE: a) Applicants with relevant Degrees or Diplomas may be admitted at 2nd or 3rd
	year level. b) Applicants for the Bachelor of Education with Science will need a Minimum of a credit in five O'Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics OR English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject
HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES	Minimum of a credit in five O'Levels including English Language and any other any four (4) subjects of which one must be an Art
NATURAL SCIENCES	Minimum of a credit in five O'Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics OR English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject.

PUBLIC HEALTH	Minimum of a credit in five O'Levels which must include English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics OR English Language, Science, Biology (or Agricultural Science) and any other acceptable subject OR a diploma in Environmental Health or related studies from a recognized institution or college affiliated to the University of Zambia.
	NOTE: (a) Applicants with only O'Level qualifications who will be admitted to the School of Public Health will be required to take first year courses in the School of Natural Sciences. (b) Applicants with A-Level or Diploma qualifications may be admitted at either second or third year level to the School of Public Health.

Please note that meeting the minimum entry requirements to any of these programmes does not guarantee admission to the programme. Admission to the programme is provisional and subject to the availability of places. Admissions into a program **may be closed before the deadline**. The University reserves the right to cancel any admission obtained based on false documents.

Applicants who had applied earlier but were not picked due to competition need not reapply but should appeal to be considered in the available programmes.

HOW TO APPLY:

Application forms can be obtained from the Customer Service Centre, UNZA Great East Road campus, upon payment of a non-refundable application fee of K150.00 for Zambians or USD 60.00 for non-Zambians. Payment for application forms should be made either at Standard Chartered Bank, Account Number **0100110273800** or First National Bank Zambia (FNB), Account Number **62607694371** or ZANACO account number **0306506302182**. The account name is UNZA Registrars Department. Kindly ensure that the deposit slip bears full details of the applicant as well as the University.

In this case, the application fee still has to be made at the bank. Applicants should submit the **ORIGINAL DEPOSIT SLIP** as they submit the application and obtain an official receipt from UNZA.
