### **HOW TO APPLY:**

Application forms can be obtained from the Customer Service Centre, UNZA Great East Road campus, upon payment of a non-refundable application fee of K150.00 for Zambians or USD 60.00 for non-Zambians. Payment for application forms should be made either at Standard Chartered Bank, Account Number **0100110273800** or ZANACO account number **0306506302182**. The account name is UNZA Registrars Department. Kindly ensure that the deposit slip bears full details of the applicant as well as the University.

In this case, the application fee still has to be made at the bank. Applicants should submit the **ORIGINAL DEPOSIT SLIP** as they submit the application and obtain an official receipt from UNZA.
